

## New £20 Note

### Information Regarding Upgrades to the New £20 Note

The Bank of England issued a new-style £20 note on 13 March 2007. The note features Adam Smith on the back and incorporates enhanced security features. It is the same size and predominately the same colour as the old-style £20 note.

The old-style £20 notes will continue to circulate alongside the new-style note. Old-style notes will be progressively withdrawn from circulation. The date when its legal tender status ends has yet to be announced.

#### Upgrade process:

There are two ways of upgrading to the new-style £20 note:

1. Return your existing note validator to the factory for an upgrade.
2. Order an advance replacement validator and once received return your old one to the factory.

The following types of validators which are fitted to D.M. (Kent) Electronics machines can be upgraded:

When contacting the factory please have ready the machine serial number (silver label on the outside of machine) and the validator type. If you are unsure of the validator type then we can check it against the serial number.

Please note non account customers will be charged the full amount of a new validator for advance replacement items and will receive a credit when the old validator is returned.
